## Bus Services 2009

- 1. Dural, Castle Hill, Galston and other north west services** to remain as for 2008. These services are provided in the main, by Hills Bus and detailed timetables maybe accessed at [http://www.hillsbus.com.au/school\\_zone/index.asp](http://www.hillsbus.com.au/school_zone/index.asp) Applications for passes are available from the School Transport Officer Mr Max Yates
- 2. St Ives - Gordon Bus**  
This service, provided by Shorelink, will commence in 2009 from St Ives (outside Memorial Ave Reserve) at 7.05 am, picking up at Gordon Station at 7.15 am. Two return services will operate each school afternoon except Friday when the service operates only at 3.30 pm. - 3. Balmain -Drummoyne**  
Commences at Darling Street Balmain and proceeds through Drummoyne along Victoria Road to School with stops at West Ryde and other points as per detailed itineraries.
- 4. Lane Cove and Hunters Hill**  
Commences near Kingsford Smith Oval Lane Cove/Longueville and proceeds along River Road and the Tarban Creek Bridge to pick up near the Hunters Hill Hotel. This service then proceeds along Ryde Road onto Victoria Road to School  
*Return services in the afternoon for 3 and 4 are usually combined so that one bus leaves the School at 3.30 pm and another at 5.15 pm after sport. Two buses will depart at approximately 3.30 pm on Fridays as there is no sport on this afternoon*
- 5. Mosman Bus**  
Commences at the intersection of Bradleys Head Road and Thompson Street (7.30 am), thence via Bradleys Head Rd, Military Road (Transit Lane) onto Warringah expressway via on ramp, Lane Cove tunnel, M2 and Pennant Hills Road to School at 8.10 am. This service returns once each afternoon as negotiated with passengers leaving at either 3.30 pm or 5.15 pm.
- 6. Strathfield Station**  
It is proposed in 2009 to commence a service departing at or around Strathfield Station and proceeding down Concord Rd, through Rhodes and onto Homebush Bay Drive, thence to Australia Avenue and Olympic Park, Hill Road and Newington Shopping Centre, Silverwater Road, Kissing Point Road, Bettington Road and TKS. Two return services in the pm will be operated. More information about this service will be available in January and families in this service area will be contacted by the School.
- 7. Pennant Hills, Beecroft, Epping and Parramatta Stations**  
Scheduled services connect the School with these railway stations. Further details about the services are available from the Transport Officer Mr Yates

**Weekly Boarders or any other boys travelling by School Bus routes on Monday morning or Friday afternoon must book their journeys with Mr Yates. The weekly boarder service on Friday afternoon may depart later than the 3.30 scheduled service, if this service is full.**
