Where To Purchase

The School Foundation runs a fully-stocked shop, The Braeside Shop, located at the School. The Braeside Shop stocks all **uniform clothing requirements** including school shoes. The Braeside Shop is the sole retailer of uniforms for The King's School.

The **Braeside Shop** is situated in Ryrie Road, beside The King's Theatre located on the campus map provided in the New Students Handbook 2018.

Items purchased can be charged to Visa, Mastercard, cheque, or EFTPOS.

Please Label all Items of Clothing

Nametags are the only acceptable form of marking boys' clothing as adhesive tapes are lost in the laundry leaving clothing without any means of identification.
