Professional Learning and Teacher Standards

The King's School continued to focus on delivering quality professional learning to its teaching community and driving their ongoing attention to the AITSL Professional Standards in 2021. The ongoing worldwide COVID-19 pandemic continued to disrupt our conventional approaches to providing professional learning across our three campuses. Furthermore, lack of clarity around the delivery of NESA Accredited Professional Learning by the School forced alternate professional learning streams to be considered.

We saw an influx of teachers and staff attending online professional learning events and undertaking higher study in Australian universities. The King's School also hosted its 7th biennial National Boys Education Conference which was attended by nearly 400 teachers (both in-person and virtually) across five Australian states and territories.

The 2021 King's School Institute Professional Learning Journal documents contributions from over 30 staff of shared learning experiences. King's staff also published over 20 peer-reviewed publications during the 2021 school year.

We also had many teachers that contributed to the many focused professional learning communities throughout the school, whether they be in departments, across departments or as a whole School community across all three campuses.

Across the School in 2021, seven teachers gained Proficient Teacher Accreditation during the course of the year. The Professional Practice and Accreditation Leader and their relevant Head of Department (Senior School staff) or Deputy Head - Academics (Preparatory School) supported teachers undergoing their Proficient Teacher Accreditation.

In July 2021, NESAs provided information around the implementation of the Accreditation of Professional Development Courses policy and streamlined accreditation offer for Individual Non-Government Schools. This encouraged schools to accept the offer of being an accredited professional development provider for the teachers within their school context. The King's School Institute were successful in again becoming an accredited professional development provider.

In acknowledging the important role schools play in developing and implementing targeted professional learning for their teachers NESAs again allowed independent schools to provide accredited courses in the four priority areas: delivery and assessment of NSW Curriculum/Early Years Learning Framework (as applicable), student/child mental health, students/children with disability, Aboriginal education and supporting Aboriginal students/children. In September 2021, NESAs streamlined the processes behind the development of accredited courses for Independent Schools. The King's School Institute have begun mapping professional development against the priority areas with the first course to be accredited being the Youth Mental Health First Aid Course in line with NESAs Accredited PD Priority Area 2 Student/ Child Mental Health.

In August 2021, the King's School Teacher Accreditation Authority (TAA) status was successfully renewed for another 5 years. As a result of The King's School TAA renewal process, all teachers at the Tudor House campus of the King's School will now be a part of The King's School TAA agreement. From the 1st of January 2022, all teachers from Tudor House will update their ETAMS and ensure that The King's School is registered as their current workplace. Formerly their workplace was listed as The King's School: Tudor House.

However, at the end of 2021, NESAs announced that in 2022 Teacher Accreditation Authority (TAA) status will be withdrawn from all organisations and be held only by NESAs. Currently, The King's School as a TAA can make proficient and maintenance accreditation decisions for their academic staff. In November 2022, this will no longer be the case. These changes have been implemented as a result of the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Abuse.

The Teacher Accreditation Amendment Bill 2021 outlining the key changes to Teacher Accreditation was assented by the NSW Minister for Education and Early Learning on the 29 November 2021. NESAs has stated 'We will engage in stakeholder consultation while developing the new requirements throughout 2022. We will provide teachers, principals, schools and sector authorities with relevant information and support before the changes come into effect.'

The King's School Institute also facilitated the LeadCOMM seminar series in a slightly different format to years past. LeadCOMM is a professional learning program designed to develop leadership excellence and the capabilities for teaching and non-teaching leaders who have the responsibility of leading and managing staff at The King's School. In 2021, LeadCOMM extended its work from the 'Brave and Faithful Conversations' led by AISNSW in 2020 to 'Brave and Faithful Decisions' into 2021-2022. LeadCOMM was also supported with three seminars on each campus each term where staff could engage in evidence-based decision making with Dr Dean Dudley or leading modern independent schools with the Headmaster Mr Tony George.

Despite the imposition of further COVID restrictions during 2021, the majority of teaching staff completed CPR and PFA (Inclusive of Anaphylaxis and Asthma). The majority of staff were also able to attend additional scheduled sessions for these courses throughout the year once COVID restrictions eased. Furthermore, all staff with responsibilities as outlined in the Emergency Management Plan received bi-annual Warden training via a webinar and the provision of online learning. A further 184 staff also completed Swim Teacher Rescue Training.
